SUBJECT: Outdoor Dining/Services Temporary Use Permit Termination

As California continues to move forward, the state is reopening and moving beyond the Blueprint for a Safer Economy. The purple, red, orange and yellow tiers that helped manage Covid-19 in Orange County are on track to end on June 15, 2021. While very limited measures will remain, Californians will see life returning to pre-Covid operations.

What does this mean?

All Outdoor Temporary Use Permits issued during the State's stay-at-home order will be terminated on June 15, 2021 and must be removed by June 30, 2021. Once the temporary outdoor area is removed, the applicant of the Temporary Use Permit is responsible for returning the existing paving to its original state. The Planning Division will send all Temporary Use Permit holders an email and mail notice the week of June 8, 2021.

What if a business wants to continue operating outdoors?

If a business seeks to continue outdoor operations after June 30, 2021 a new Temporary Use Permit application shall be submitted to the Planning Division for review. A Temporary Use Permit has a time limit not to exceed four calendar days within a 90-day period.

The completed application shall be submitted with the minimum processing deposit of \$200 by email to planning@cityofbrea.net or at the front counter on the 3rd floor of 1 Civic Center Circle.
