



Curtis Theatre Amplify:

A Forum for Marginalized Voices

The Curtis Theatre is calling for artist submissions for the inaugural ***Amplify*** series of performances. These performances seek to platform artists from communities underrepresented in the performing arts, and boost the voices of artists who have been quieted within the industry. Works are not required to center around a specific community or personal identity, but should speak with the artist's own unique voice.

Submitted works will be reviewed by the Amplify Advisory board, who will choose works to be featured as part of the Curtis Theatre Season. Amplify performances will be given rehearsal and performance time, marketing and promotional support, and artists will receive compensation.

For the sake of equity and representation, diversity among artists chosen to perform. This is particularly true as the program takes shape during this initial year. People of all backgrounds, including (but not limited to) Black, Indigenous, People of Color, Asian-American and Pacific Islanders, Pan-Ethnic, Women, Persons with Disabilities, and LGBTQIA+ communities are encouraged to participate both as artists and Advisory Board members.
