STATE ROUTE 57 SHOULDER WIDENING PROJECT UNDERWAY SOUTHBOUND LAMBERT ROAD OFF-RAMP

Irvine – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has a construction project set to begin Monday, March 21, 2016 at the southbound Lambert Road Off -ramp to 0.2 mile North of Lambert Road Undercrossing in the city of Brea. The \$1 million shoulder widening project will include full 55-hour weekend closures of the Off-ramp. Caltrans will notify motorists in advance of the scheduled 55-hour closures. Detour signs will be posted to alert motorists.

The scope of the 180 day project includes:

- Shoulder widening and landscaping Off-ramp only
- Modifying curbs, gutter and drainage of the southbound Off/On-ramps

	<i>The dedicated right turn lane on East Lambert Rd onto the SB tangent On-ramp and North State College Blvd designated far right turn lane will also be closed concurrent with the 55-hour closures.</i>
